Kurt Ramin

Kurt Ramin is currently Chairman of XBRL International Steering Committee.

Mr. Ramin is XBRL Team Leader at the International Accounting Standards Committee Foundation, based at the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB) in London, where he previously held the position of Commercial Director. Before moving to London, he spent ten years in PriceWaterhouseCoopers New York office as a partner in their Capital Markets Practice. Prior to that, he served as CFO of several companies in the USA and Germany.

Mr. Ramin is a founding director of the non-profit CIPA Examination Network, which administers uniform Russian language qualification examinations based on International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) for accountants and financial specialist in Ukraine and 8 other NIS countries.

Mr. Ramin holds an MBA from Central Michigan University and a BA from Fachhochschule Cologne, Germany. He is a CPA (New York) and a Certified Employee Benefits Specialist (CEBS) through Wharton School. He is a member of the Financial Executives International (FEI) and past president of one of their largest chapters. Kurt has published articles on International Accounting and Capital Markets in international handbooks and magazines. Mr. Ramin was a member of the High Level Expert Group of the European Union on "The Intangible Economy Impact and Policy Issues" and other related knowledge industry initiatives.

Maciej Piechocki

Maciej Piechocki graduated from the University of Economics in Poznan in Poland and the Technical University Freiberg in Germany, where he studied Business Administration with majors in Finance and Information Technology. In the area of the Financial Statement Analysis he is the author of the insolvency prediction model used by auditors in Poland. Currently, he is a research assistant at the Chair of Information Systems in Freiberg, where he lectures in Information Technology and Computer Science. He is completing his PhD conjointly in Germany and Poland, researching XBRL and Business Reporting Supply Chain and the impact of XBRL and IFRS. Mr. Piechocki is initiator of XBRL in Poland and the founding member of the XBRL Poland Association. He is also responsible for taxonomy development activities there.

As a member of the IASCF XBRL Team Mr. Piechocki is involved in numerous IFRS related projects and his main area of interest is development of the IFRS taxonomy.
